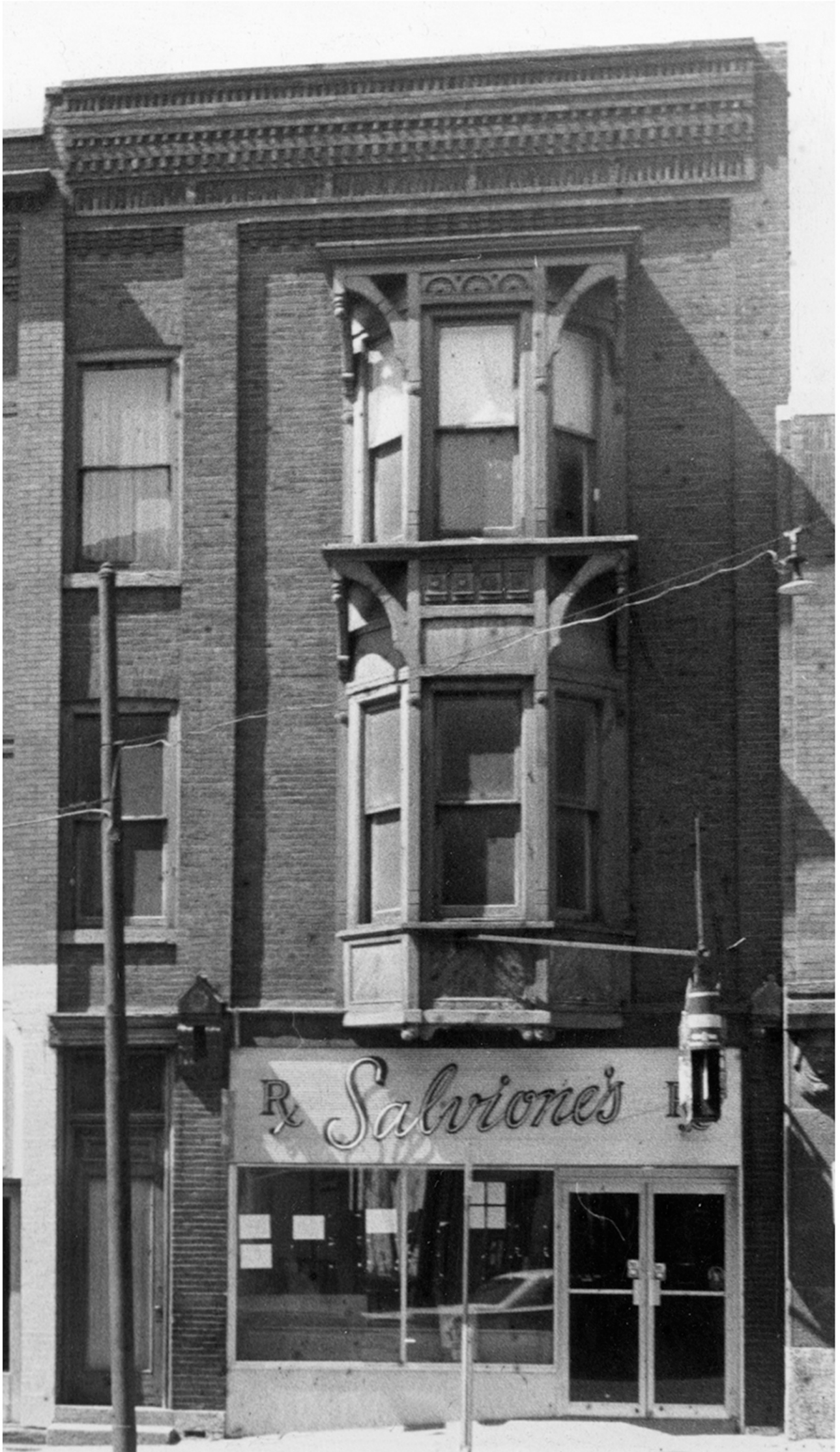


Arterial Scrapbook No. 51



THIRD OF CONDEMNED BUILDINGS - Located at 44 Market St. and somewhat similar to No. 42 is a building that came out of the Gay Nineties as a tavern and held that same status through most of the years it has been standing. At the turn of the century the proprietors were Monaghan & Noonan and a few years later John Noonan took over as sole operator of the grill. He was succeeded by Joseph Weiss. During the early 1930's the Mohawk Lunch took possession, that in turn succeeded by the Rialto Restaurant in 1935. When the food business was transferred to the Meola Bldg. on the easterly side of Market opposite Division in 1947 the SLA license again appeared in the window at No. 44, this time under the operation of John J. Kennedy. Various tavern operators continued to 1959 and the last was James R. Pepe. Most recent owner of the building was Fred Salvione. (Arterial Scrapbook No. 51 - Donlon)
